## Notes

1. In order to maintain reversibility middle dot (·) is added if the sign of absence of inherent vowel (ஃ) should be followed by an independent vowel character.
2. In the UN romanization middle dot is omitted.
3. In local romanization: ch → (often) s, k → g<sup>A</sup>, t → th/d<sup>A</sup>, t̄ → t/d<sup>A</sup> (<sup>A</sup> – between vowels).
