

 We updated the act on 1 July 2013 by making the following improvements:



- Geometry of the named feature
 - the shape of the street
- Names can be given to groups of features
 - Archipelagos or bus stops
- The place name data -

the data which describes the language features of a name, the geometry and also the establishment of a place name.



An entry into the Place Names Register may now be based on the data of another state database that maintains the named feature as basic data.



- In 2012 and 2013, the status of 3 villages, Külitse, Räni and Vasula, were changed into small boroughs
- and there are three new villages: Koidu, Sandimetsa and Uuesalu.

The Merger of Local Governments

• When the local governments (226 at the moment) merge, they choose a new name for themselves. As of October, there will be 215 local governments and three of those will have new municipality names: Lääne-Nigula, Hiiu and Viljandi.
