Macedonian Cyrillic

The United Nations recommended system was approved in 1977 (III/11), based on the romanization of the Serbo-Croatian and Macedonian Cyrillic alphabets that had long been employed in official gazetteers and maps of Yugoslavia. The table was published as an annex to the resolution¹.

The system is used in The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia² and in international cartographic products. An alternative system is described in the orthography manual of the language³.

The Cyrillic alphabet is used. The romanization table is unambiguous and can be applied automatically. The system is mostly reversible, but occasionally romanized characters dz, $d\tilde{z}$, lj may represent character combinations in Cyrillic (дз, дж, лј) instead of single characters (s, ц, љ). Also, both characters Γ and κ or Γ and Γ may occur before e and Γ . So, for example, the name Makedonija is reconstituted as Γ Makeдohuja, not Γ Makeдohuja in the Cyrillic source script.

Other systems of romanization

The **alternative system** given in the language manual³ romanizes, as a single block, the following characters differently from the UN system (the Cyrillic character is followed in parentheses by the romanization according to the UN system):
